Martha M. Ertman is the Carole & Hanan Sibel Research Professor at the University of Maryland.

Prof Ertman's research is on the role of contracts and mini-contracts she calls "deals" in family relationships.

Professor Ertman's new book, *Love's Promises: How Formal & Informal Contracts Shape All Kinds of Families* (Beacon Press 2015), reaches a broad audience by blending memoir with family law stories about exchanges in reproductive technology, adoption, cohabitation, and marriage. It was Family Equality Council's 2015 Book Club Pick, a finalist for the Next Generation Indie Book Awards, and covered by media.

Her other law review articles and book chapters uncover the often-hidden role of contracts and deals in the legal rules governing the value of homemaking labor; what she calls "Plan B" baby-making through reproductive technologies; and polygamy; her book *Rethinking Commodification: Cases and Readings in Law and Culture* (with Joan Williams) (NYU Press 2005) explores the reach of markets into all areas of our lives.
