General Conditions:

The scholarships are intended for excellent master and doctoral students and for researchers who received their PhD within the past four years.

The scholarships are subject to the regulations of the Hebrew University for <u>Master and Doctoral Scholarships</u> and for <u>Post-Doctoral Scholarships</u>

Scholarship recipients will be required to ensure regular attendance and involvement in academic activities. Instructions for Submitting Applications

Candidacy should be submitted in a digital format to the relevant scholarship address.

Applications must include the following components:

- A. Resume
- B. Transcripts of undergraduate and master studies (for master and doctoral students)
- C. Brief description of the research project (up to two pages, for master and doctoral students)
- D. Letter of recommendation from the thesis supervisor and the intended supervisor (for doctoral students)
- E. Declaration of intent regarding future plans (for master and doctoral students)
- F. A request for a scholarship on socioeconomic grounds should be submitted on the form
- G. Description of subjects the candidate seeks to research during the scholarship period (up to two pages, for master and doctoral students)
- H. Two letters of recommendation, one of which will be from the doctoral supervisor (for post-doctoral students)
